

## Larkspur of Henley



Larkspur of Henley is a 90% Dutch rebuild (2006) of the 30 ft slipper launch Larkspur built by Hobbs (1939/1946), using replicated parts meticulously copied from the originals. These were reassembled in wood core epoxy creating an extremely rigid hull. Her graceful lines and re-use of the original Honduras mahogany (unsplined!) deck and cockpit make her an excellent example of a rare breed of beauty. Fitted out with modern equipment; Yanmar 3GM30 27HP diesel with teleflex engine control, hydraulic steering, VDO classic instruments (+rudder angle), electrical bilge pump. Overall canvas cover in 3 parts (zipper). Currently housed inside, near Amsterdam.
